

Denver, CO

Description:

- It really is a mile high; mild, pleasant summer climate with low humidity; scenic location at the base of the Rocky Mountains
- 2.7 million people in the greater metro area
- Denver International Airport is served by 19 major carriers

Architectural interest:

- The Brown Palace Hotel, 1892 - luxurious Italian Renaissance style; architecturally themed private tours available
- Arapahoe Acres Historical District - first post-WWII subdivision to be on National Historic Register; 124 unique, modern homes
- Colorado State Capitol building, 1980s
- The ("Unsinkable") Molly Brown house, 1886 - eclectic mix of Queen Anne, Richardson Romanesque and Neoclassical
- Stapleton – new development built on the grounds of the former Denver airport, referencing the building styles of historic Denver

Other points of interest:

- Denver Art Museum – acclaimed for its enormous Native American collection; also has an architectural and graphic design curatorial department
- 16th Street Mall and several other shopping and dining districts
- Denver Zoo, Denver Mint, Botanical Gardens, 850 miles of bike trails
- Golden (nearby) – Coors Brewery, Red Rocks Amphitheater, Buffalo Bill Museum
- Rocky Mountain National Park
