

Sacramento CA

Description:

- Sacramento is one of the California's fastest-growing areas with a metro-area population of nearly 1.8 million.
- River City's downtown area tree-shaded streets are with some impressive Victorians and well-crafted bungalows. At its heart sits the majestic capitol building -- Sacramento's most visible attraction -- situated within a large park, replete with flower gardens, memorial statuary, and curious squirrels.
- **Sacramento International Airport** ([IATA: SMF](#), [ICAO: KSMF](#), [FAA LID: SMF](#)) is a public [airport](#) located 10 miles (16 km) northwest of the [central business district](#) (CBD) of [Sacramento](#), in [Sacramento County, California, USA](#). It is run by Sacramento County. [Southwest Airlines](#) currently accounts for about half of all airline passengers at the airport. Long dominated by [Southwest](#) and [United](#) ([United Express](#)), the intra-California market was joined in 2011 by [American](#) ([American Eagle](#)) and [Delta](#) ([Delta Connection](#)) which fly from [Los Angeles International Airport](#)

Architectural interest:

- Sacramento is graced with scores of historically significant buildings, homes and places. The history of the city is captured and reflected in architecture that reaches back to the days of the Gold Rush. Sacramento Heritage is dedicated to preserving, protecting and maintaining these historic places so that future generations may enjoy and appreciate the city's robust past.
